Sub : Police Estt: - Grade Designation as ASI on completion of 20 years of Qualifying service- orders issued - reg.

In order to bolster the sagging morale of the police personnel who have not been benefited by promotions for a long period, the Government had accorded sanction to designate the Police Constables of General Executive ( Civil Police Officers and Senior Civil Police Officers ) who have completed 23 years of service as Grade ASI vide Govt. order cited first. As per the order cited Second the Govt. have accorded sanction to designate the Grade Senior Civil Police Officers who have completed 23 years of service and passed the General Head Constable Test and against whom no disciplinary action is pending be given Grade Designation as "Grade ASI" subject to the condition that there will not be any additional financial commitment on the part of the Government. As per the order 3rd cited, the period for designation as ASI (Gr) has been reduced to 22 years including training period. Further the Govt. have reduced the period for designation as ASI (Gr) to 20 years including training period vide the reference cited fourth.

To designate the regular or grade Senior Civil Police Officer, as ASI (Grade), the following conditions are to be satisfied.

- 1) Senior Civil Police Officers / Civil Police Officers must be serving in the (GE) Branch (Local) and must have completed 20 years of service respectively including basic training period.
- 2) SCPOs and SCPOs (Gr.) must be drawing a pay in the scale of pay equal to or higher than that of ASI.
- 3) The SCPO / SCPO (Gr.) designated as ASI (Grade) will be promoted to the cadre of regular ASI as and when his turn comes in the regular line of promotion unless found ineligible and strictly on the basis of the position in the seniority list of regular SCPOs on the recommendation of the DPB and the terms and conditions as followed.
- 4) The SCPO / SCPO (Gr.) designated as ASI(Grade) will be eligible to wear the uniform of the regular ASI.
- 5) He will not be eligible to draw higher pay and allowances other than what he would have been receiving in the rank of SCPO.
- 6) The SCPO designated as ASI(Grade) authorized to perform all the duties and responsibilities of a regular ASI and are also responsible for discharge the duties of a regular SCPO.
- 7) The SCPO designated as ASI (Grade) will not have any claim of seniority in the category of a regular ASI on the basis of their designation as ASI (G).
- 8) The ASI (Grade) will only be posted in any unit / Spl.unit against the vacancy of regular SCPO.
- 9) These order will not alter the existing rules with regard to the

disciplinary authority under KPDIP & A Rules and Manual of Disciplinary Proceedings. This means that the ASI (Grade) will be treated as regular SCPO in respect of any departmental action as per KPDIP & A Rules.

As such the following Police personnel who have completed 20 years of service including basic training period are designated as ASI (Grade) with immediate effect.
